Purpose of the paper	This is to update the committee on the work carried out to support engagement with STEM for young people across Shetland			
Brief summary of the paper	The paper (UHI STEM Outreach Programme - Information sheet 2023-24 - English UPDATED 12 SEP 24.pdf) gives an update on STEM activity carried out through the UHI STEM outreach programme which we participate in through our locally appointed STEM coordinator who is also supported through the DEFRA funded Seafood fund. In Shetland we contribute to the STEM Partnership and network which is going from strength to strength and one aspect of the work to highlight is the development of the STEM hub - <u>Shetland STEM hub</u> . This is aimed at local teachers and provides clarity on different resources available from the various STEM partners. Another area to highlight is the regional STEM equipment. This is a pool of the more expensive kit (individual items can be £1-2.5K and depending on class size you may need 2-6 sets of kit). UHI have been able to add about £20K from the programme to this central equipment store in addition to proving a complete set of equipment to the STEM Coordinators for bespoke UHI Lend a Labs. UHI have also received some very generous donations in this regard. Hosted at the STEM Store in Inverness there is a booking system and through a courier it delivers to the STEM Coordinators routinely within 2-3 days.
